

Lanny F. Davis Memorial Scholarship
and
Community Theatre of Howell Scholarship

The Community Theatre of Howell (CTH) will present scholarships up to \$300 to graduating seniors who intend to pursue a major and have been accepted into a 2-year or 4-year performing arts (acting, directing, design, technical, dance, vocal, instrumental performance, teacher of the performing arts, video/film production, or management) curriculum.

Qualifications:

1. Student must be a current paid member of CTH (*this will be verified with the CTH membership chairman*)
2. Student must have participated significantly in CTH productions during the high school years
3. Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
4. Student must have been accepted into and pursuing a 2-year or 4-year major in the performing arts post high school.

How to apply:

*Applications and support materials are due **no later than 12:00 noon, Saturday, February 11, 2012.***

*Applicants will be reviewed by the CTH Awards Committee and recipients will be chosen and notified no later than **Wednesday, March 7, 2012.** All applications and support materials outlined below must be sent via e-mail as a pdf document. 1. Student must fill out an official application form (download from www.cththeatre.org under education)
2. Student must submit a 250 word essay on the following topic when applying for this scholarship: How has CTH affected your life and how will a performing arts degree and career shape your life?
3. Student must submit two letters of recommendation (only one of which can come from a current CTH board member)
4. Student must submit an acceptance letter from the college/university that they will be attending in the fall.
5. Student must send a transcript of high school courses and cumulative GPA.

Award

The check will be presented by a CTH board member to the award winning student(s) at their high school honors assembly.
