Lion/Zeke – Scene 1-1-6 through 1-1-7 (Em, Hickory, Hunk, Zeke, Dorothy), Scene 2-11-50 to 2-11-51, CB Scene 1-12-63 to 1-12-64 *middle of page*

Gulch/Wicked Witch – Scene 1-3-10 to 1-3-11 *until Dorothy enters*, Scene 1-7-35 to 1-7-36, CB Scene 2-10-46 “Choose to Die” Monologue in center AND 2-10-47 “Melt” Monologue

Glinda – Scene 1-6-27 to 1-6-29 (Dorothy), Scene 1-7-35 to 1-7-36

Auntie Em – Scene 1-1-6 through 1-1-7 (Em, Hickory, Hunk, Zeke, Dorothy), Scene 1-3-10 to 1-3-11 *until Dorothy enters*

Uncle Henry – Scene 1-3-10 to 1-3-11 *until Dorothy enters*

Guard – Scene 2-1-2 through 2-1-3

Marvel/Wizard – Scene 1-4-20 (middle of page) to 1-4-21, Scene 2-11-50 to 2-11-51

Winkie General – Scene 2-10-47 to 2-10-48
